

4.3.1 Institution frequently updates its IT facilities and provides sufficient bandwidth for internet connection

East Point College of Pharmacy has expanded its information technology facilities to support faculty members in their teaching, learning, and research activities. Students can also make use of these IT resources to better understand their future careers and make better use of the technologies at their disposal. Students are receiving similar services to make sure they are aware of current events. All academic and administrative operations are supported by the college's well-equipped IT infrastructure. Additionally, it offers services to students to help them maximise the resources of the facility and develop a better awareness of possible career paths. Similar services are being extended to our students in order to assist them in keeping up with material that may not be included in textbooks or that may become outdated by the time it is taught in a traditional setting.

Numerous venues, including, offices, computer laboratories, and libraries, have an abundance of computers equipped with printers, scanners, projectors, and internet connectivity. There are numerous computers with printers, scanners, and internet connection available in various areas, including offices, computer laboratories, and the library. Three computers on campus are used exclusively for administrative tasks, and all other computers are connected to the internet via a Local Area Network (LAN). The entire campus of the college is currently connected to a 1000 MBPS fibre-optic internet connection. Upgraded dual-band access points have been installed to improve internet coverage around campus, allowing students to access the internet via PCs and mobile devices. A number of Port Switches (24*2, 8*1) service the campus's IT infrastructure and deliver power over Ethernet.

Since the institution believes that having a sufficient IT infrastructure is necessary to provide high-quality education, it has given the development of IT infrastructure and its timely upgrades top priority. The institute's ongoing efforts to build ICT-enabled classrooms, teaching and learning activities have resulted in improved computer use for both academic and administrative work.
