# **About the college:**

East Point College of Pharmacy was established in the year 2004 by M. G. Charitable Trust Bangalore. The College is affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS), Bangalore and Drugs Control Department, Bangalore. The College offers *D. Pharm., B. Pharm., M. Pharm., and Pharm. D., Programs*. The programs are approved by PCI and Govt of Karnataka. There are around 650 students studying D. Pharm, B. Pharm, M. Pharm and Pharm. D with 46 faculty members involved in Teaching and Research. A 20% among the faculty have PhD qualification. B. Pharm. students have been performing well in university exams. In the RGUHS University exams, B. Pharm. students bagged up *12 University Ranks*. Similar results are also available for prior years. A minimum of 10 papers are being published annually in high indexed Journals by the faculty members and PG students. Almost all students get placements at the end of the program in many multinational companies with high packages. A few students pursue higher education abroad.

The College has sufficient ICT enabled smart class rooms, well equipped advanced laboratories and Library to run the classes. College has a computer Lab with high end configurations to train students on simulations and have procured a number of software's like *Lexicomp*, *Ex Pharm*, etc. College has an excellent *Museum* with anatomical models and physiological organs. There is a very big animal house with rats, mice and rabbits.

The library has more than 9546 books and subscribed 19 National and International journals and subscription to Helinet. College encourages faculty members to attend seminar, conferences organized by other Colleges and industries. Also, faculty have been given the freedom to organize seminars, conferences and faculty development programs annually. Every year at least 5-6 seminars/conferences/FDP are being conducted. A separate seminar hall is available within the college for organizing seminars and conferences.

The College has entered into MOU with a number of multinational Pharmaceutical Industries and Hospitals. On Campus, a 750 bedded East Point hospital is located. Students are provided with the opportunity do their internship and training at this hospital. Students are trained to operate the Pharmacy section of the hospital. Almost all students undergo internship in well-

known Pharma companies in and around Bangalore. Since the College is located on a multi college campus, students have opportunities to interact with students of Engineering, Medical, Nursing, Management, Commerce and Science. Students have Transport, Hostel and Sports facilities.

The College organizes Fresher's Day, Pharmacy Week and Farewell day, Teacher's Day and College Day in addition to Cultural Day and Sports Day for the benefit of students. East Point College of Pharmacy also offers a two-year Diploma Program in Pharmacy with an intake of 60. The College is located in the eastern part of Bangalore at Bidarahalli, Virgo Nagar Post, off old Madras Road.
