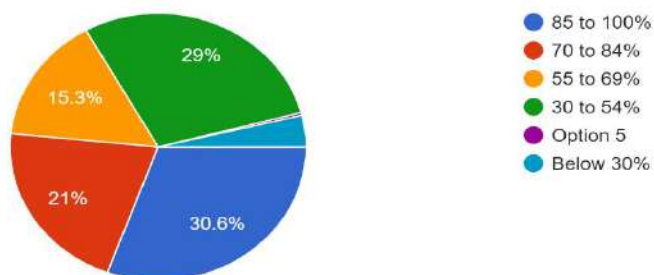

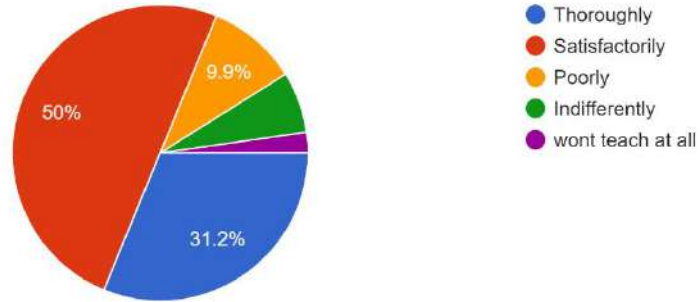
1. How much syllabus was covered in the class

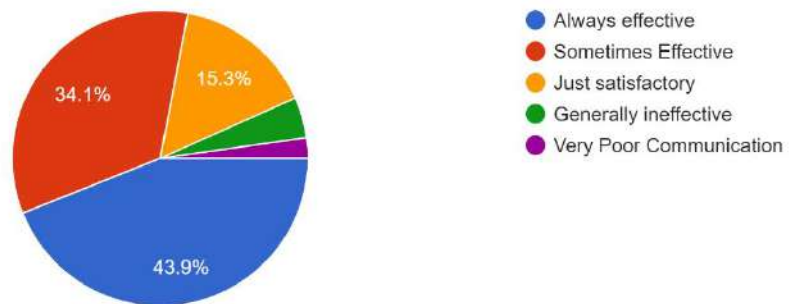
2. How well did the the teachers prepare for the classes

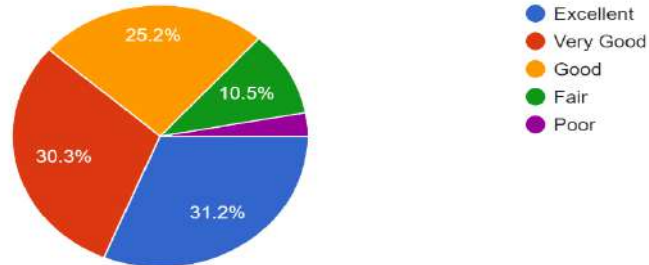
3. How well were the teachers able to communicate

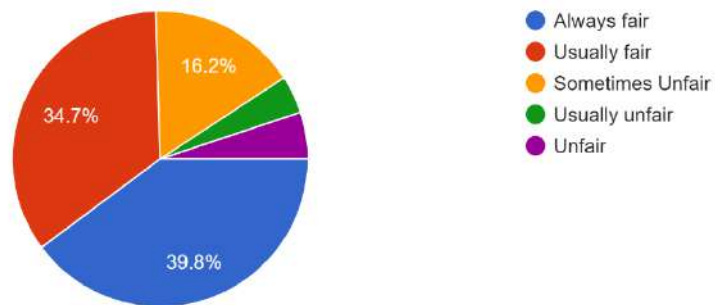
4. The teachers approach to teaching can be best described as

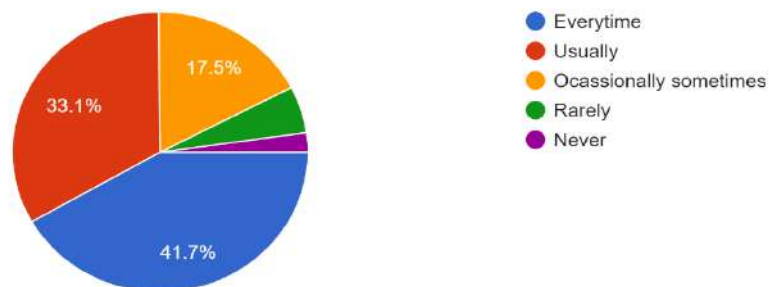
5. Fairness of internal valuation process by the teachers

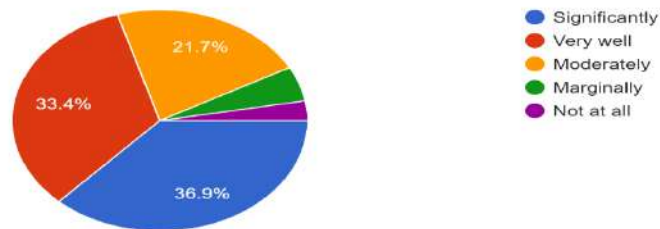

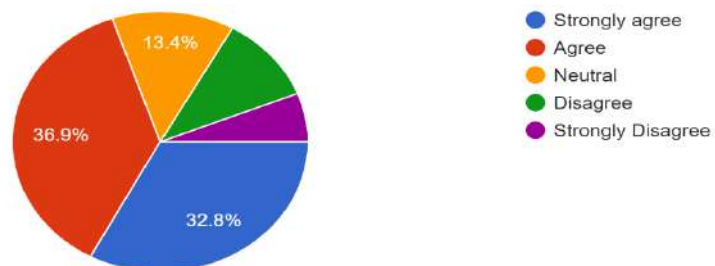
8. The teaching and mentoring Process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive social and emotional growth

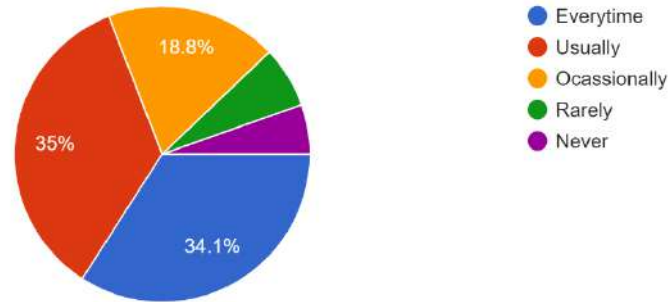

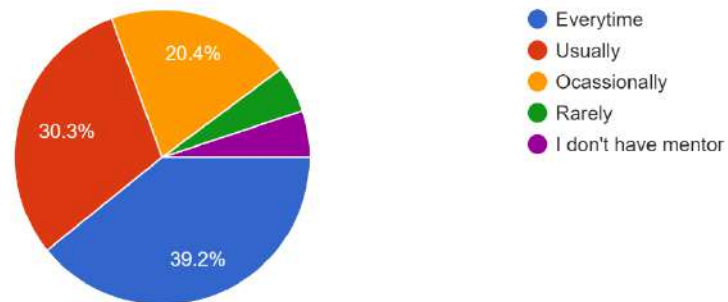

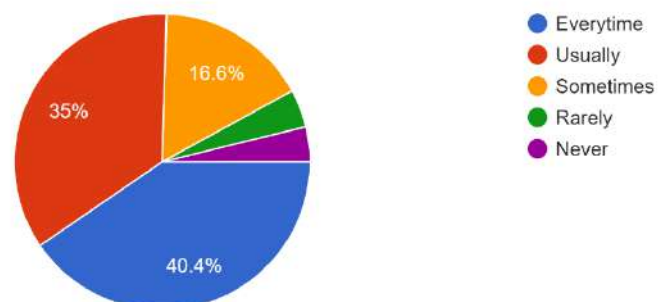

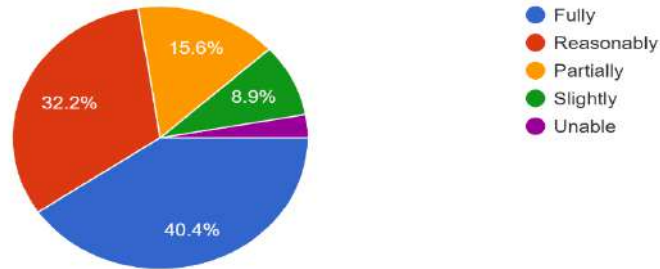
12. The teachers illustrate the concepts through examples and applications.

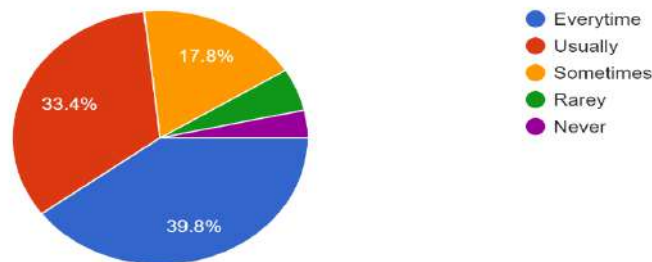

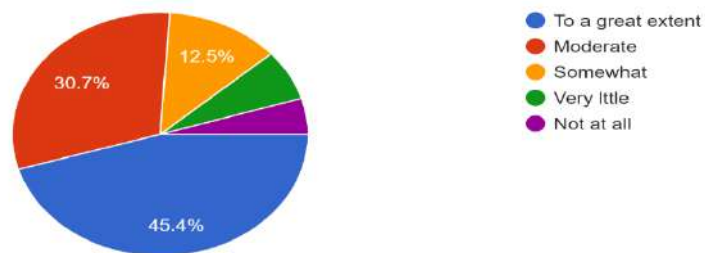
