After detailed deliberations in the BOS (UG-Pharmacy) meeting held on 21/05/2020 and decisions of syndicate and academic councils (Ref nos 3-7) Passing criteria of B.Pharmacy course are revised. In exercise of the powers vested under section 35(2) of RGUHS Act, 1994, it is notified as below:

- 1) A student shall be declared pass and eligible for getting grade in the B.Pharma course if he/she secures at least 50% marks in each theory subjects including internal assessment marks, provided a minimum of 35% marks is scored in each theory subject in the end semester university examination.
- 2) The benefit of grace marks shall be up to a total of 5 marks per semester with a maximum of 3 marks in any one subject, provided the student passes all the subjects of that semester.

The above guidelines shall be applicable for students of semester scheme admitted from the academic year 2020-21 batch and onwards.
