SYLLABUS

Practicals:

Hospital postings for a minimum of 6 months period is required to understand the principles and practice involved in ward round participation and clinical discussion on selection of drug therapy. Students are required to maintain a log book of cases and the different clinical pharmacy activities done in the ward and the same should be submitted at the end of the course for evaluation. Each student should present the medical cases they have observed and followed in the wards.

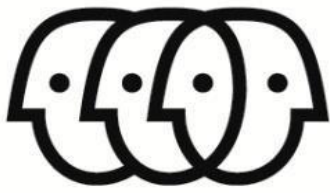

PRACTICAL DESCRIPTION:

Pharm D fifth-year students are assigned to East Point Hospital, where they rotate through departments such as General Medicine, General Surgery, Paediatrics, Emergency Medicine, Psychiatric unit, and Hospital Pharmacy. During their posting, students are required to collect patient cases and perform clinical pharmacy-related activities.

Each case and all other activities must be documented in the respective form like Drug interaction, Adverse Drug Reaction Reporting form, Drug information query form etc. provided by the Department of Pharmacy Practice at East Point College of Pharmacy. After collecting each case, students will discuss and present their findings and document them in the record. These documented activities will then be submitted to the respective subject in charge for review.
